



1. MAX OUT **ON MASCARA**

"2016 is definitely the year of the spider-thick lashes," says Terry Barber, Mac director of make-up artistry. "Apply several coats of mascara to top and bottom lashes - I call it 'max mascara' - for a '60s, Bardot look." Luckily, there's a whole new wardrobe of lash dressers to help us come January: Rimmel's ground-breaking mascara tints lashes over time, while Bobbi Brown's Eye Opening Mascara will stretch and curl with that all-important long-wear formula we love BB for. And Benefit adds a tinted primer to its They're Real! collection - with an extra-flexible brush to make easy work of coating and separating each and every lash.





2. BE INSPIRED BY THE '90s

The '90s are back in a big way. "But this time they're pretty," says Alexia Inge, founder of cultbeauty.co.uk. "Lipliner, in particular, is going to be huge again, but will tackle anti-ageing and the condition of your lips too." We're excited about Smashbox's new Lip Mattifier, launching in April, and the new Kaplan MD lip pencil, which contains peptides and marine collagen to plump lips over time. Our top colour tip? Berry - so '90s. Mac also gives a nod to the era, with a collection inspired by the late '90s Latina pop star Selena, as requested by fans in an online petition. We hope that means a LOT of matte tawny-red lips! "Lipgloss will be huge, too," says Terry, "Just the right amount of balmy gloss in coral or pink." We're taking inspiration from the Dior S/S16 show, where gloss took centre stage. And finally, Lipstick Queen's Saint & Sinner Lip Tints launch in January, followed by Clinique's Pop Artistry Pop Glaze Sheer – a balmy, super-sheer lipstick – the month after. ▶

"I predict a big rise in brightening products, which even skintone and inhibit melanin production," says facialist Sarah Chapman. "The skin revolution continues in make-up," says Terry. "Women have reclaimed that feminine soft glow of 'done skin', with good-coverage, water-based foundations, which create post-spa finishes. The glow is real - rather than the strobing look - using serums, moisturisers and primers, with a fine veil of colour that just fits." Look out for Shiseido's Synchro Skin Liquid Lasting Foundation - advanced 'sensing' technology to synchronise the tone with your own skin - out in March; and in February, Nars' innovative new Velvet Matte Skin Tint (as used at Thakoon S/S16) and Laura Mercier's Candleglow Soft Luminous



6. WATCH THIS

Blow Ltd's first-ever collection, #10MinuteBlow, features six styling products and launches in January with a series of How To video links so you can perfect your blow-dry skills at home. We already love the Party-Proof Hairspray £10 blowltd.com

8. NEW SPA ALERT!
